Literacy and English

This term, we are looking forward to writing our very own creative stories. We will be focusing on writing a series of two and three linked sentences with each sentence having a capital letter at the beginning and a full stop at the end.

Children will continue to develop their decoding skills and knowledge of sounds through their weekly group reader.

This term, we begin revising consonant digraphs as well as focusing on consonant blends ensuring the children are secure in blending before introducing consonant vowel digraphs.

We will continue to revise and consolidate the formation of all the letters including capital letters.

Numeracy and Mathematics

In numeracy, we will be continuing to focus on consolidating and extending our knowledge of numbers within 100 and addition and subtraction number facts within 30.

This term we will be learning about symmetry. We will be investigating lines of symmetry and creating symmetrical pictures. We will introduce fractions focusing on the concept that one half is one part out of two. We will also be revisiting coin recognition and simple money calculations to the value of £1.

Interdisciplinary Learning
