Try some of these ideas with your word lists – on the next page.

- With water and a paintbrush on a path or wall
- By singing each letter
- By playing spelling tennis you say one letter, a partner says the next and so on
- Using flash cards to test yourself
- Use different colours
- Write on someone's back with your magic spelling finger!
