- ✓ Forward in tens from 3 or 8.
- ✓ Forward in 5s to 100.
- ✓ Forward in 2s from 0 and forward in 2s from 1. Check out the odd and even numbers!

Read!

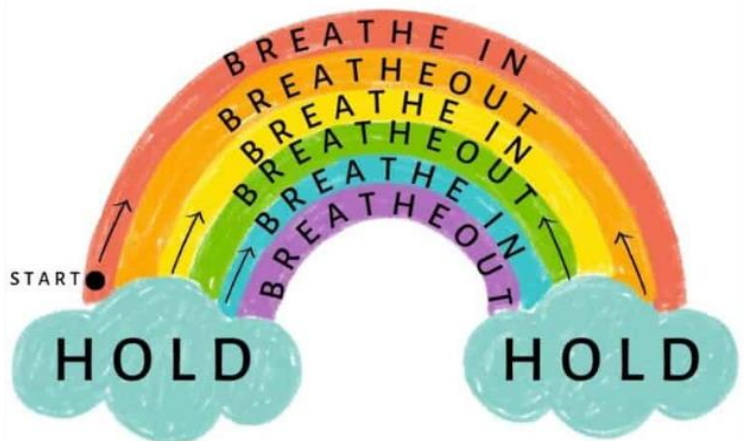
How many of these ideas will you try?
