We hope you enjoyed some quality family time over the October holidays. Please see below for details about your child's learning over Term 2. Thank you for all the help you are currently giving to support learning. It really does make a difference.

 Literacy Using Jolly Phonics actions and songs to aid learning of letter sounds – we will learn two sounds a week this term. Reading and spelling simple 3 and 4 letter words. Learning to write letters with correct formation. Learning to write our first name. Learning to read and write tricky words e.g. I, the, no, put, to, is, his. Expanding vocabulary using a weekly story as the focus. Detailed drawings and annotations using 'The Drawing Club'. Re-telling and sequencing known stories. Daily reading rotations focusing on turn taking, reading from left to right, the use of space between words, and comprehension. 		 Numeracy Sequencing numerals 1-20+. Counting forwards, backwards and numbers after/ before. Learning the 'count on' strategy and adding with one collection hidden. Estimating between 0-20. Introduce numerical signs (e.g. + and =) and writing number sentences. Maths Time – days of the week, months of the year and seasons, daily routines, reading a timetable, recognising and writing o'clock times on a digital and analogue clock. Money - Recognising, sorting and matching coins up to £2. Adding coins to 'pay' for items.	
<u>Learning through Play</u> Though carrying out individual and group observations as well as weekly learner conversations, play provisions are constantly evolving to reflect and respond to the interests of the class.
