Below is a selection of activities that can be worked on individually, by your child, or together as a family. They can share their work with their class if they wish.

Reading

Please encourage your child to read for pleasure and/or purpose. It doesn't always have to be a book - it can be a magazine, instructions for a game or how to build something, a shopping list or ingredients for a recipe.

Topic

This term we will be studying Scotland and the Rainforest as our topic.

Can you create a fact file about one animal you might find in Scotland or the rainforest? Remember to include information such as their habitat, diet, survival techniques. You could present this as a booklet or a PowerPoint presentation. Please bring these in to share as we would love to see them!

Health & Wellbeing

Keep a kindness jar at home. Each member of the family should write something kind about each other and put it in the jar. You could try adding to it each week and open it together at the end of the term.

Literacy

This January we will be learning a Scots poem or song. Everyone will have a chance to perform this in front of the class for a chance to be selected to perform at Scots Night! Make sure you put in the practice- you could get a family member to help you.

Can you find out the height of the different members of your family or pets. How did you measure them and what did you use? You could use both standard and non-standard units e.g hands and centimeters
