## Literacy and English

This term, we are looking forward to enjoying together our first class novel 'The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark'. We hope that through sharing this novel we will prompt a love and enjoyment of reading, develop listening and talking skills through class discussions. Children will continue to develop their decoding skills and knowledge of sounds through their weekly group reader. Please ensure your child brings their reading folder to school **daily**.

This term we begin with consolidating our Block 2 Edinburgh Literacy Rich Sounds before beginning Block 3 blends.

We will continue to revise and consolidate the correct formation of all the letters including capital letters.

## Admin

Our PE days are Wednesday (P2A)/ Thursday (P2B). Throughout the week there will be opportunities for more P.E focusing on Yoga, Zumba, Fitness Workouts and 'Party Games' in preparation of our school Christmas Party! School uniform is fine for this type of activity.

Outdoor learning sessions will be on a Tuesday. We will be participating in outdoor learning in most weathers. Please could children wear appropriate clothing. Children are welcome to change into wellies for outdoor learning.

## Numeracy and Mathematics

In numeracy, we will be continuing to focus on consolidating our knowledge of addition and subtraction number facts. We will be extending our learning through developing strategies to solve problems and calculating missing numbers within a number sentence, developing mental agility of number bonds.

This term will be learning about time. Firstly, building upon prior learning through revising reading and recording 'o'clock' on an analogue and digital clock. Through investigation we will learn that there are 60 minutes in an hour and make links with fractions to help the children read and record half past on an analogue and digital clock.

## Learning Across the Curriculum

### Science

This term we will be 'Zooming to the Moon' and on our way we will be learning all about:

- Planet Earth
- The Moon, Sun and Stars
- Day and Night

We will be making our own Rocket models this term, if you could send in any recyclable 'junk' (e.g. kitchen roll tubes, clean plastic bottles, empty tissue boxes) it would be much appreciated!

### Outdoor Learning

Last session the children thoroughly enjoyed learning about fire safety and the associated dangers. This term we will reinforce ways in which to keep safe around fire, linking with upcoming festivities such as Bonfire Night.

### RME

This session the children will be learning all about Christmas traditions and customs.

### Health and Wellbeing

With the dark mornings and afternoons upon us, we will be learning about ways to keep ourselves safe when crossing the road. We will investigate how we can be bright and be seen by wearing fluorescent and reflective items of clothing. In class, we will also reinforce and extend the children's knowledge of firework safety.
