Literacy and English

This term, we are looking forward to enjoying 'The Lighthouse Keeper' series of stories. We hope that through sharing these wonderful stories we will prompt a love and enjoyment of reading, develop listening and talking skills through class discussions.

This term we begin with revising all of the initial sounds and focus on rhyme before progressing to learning the initial final consonant blends;

Children will continue to develop their decoding skills and knowledge of sounds through their weekly group reader. Please ensure your child brings their reading folder to school **daily** and that it remains in their school bag throughout the week.

We will continue to revise and consolidate the formation of all letters including capital letters. Each week we look forward to our writing sessions to reinforce our skills in sentence construction and storytelling.

Numeracy and Mathematics

In Numeracy, we will be revising number sequencing, counting forwards and backwards, addition and subtraction within 20.

In Maths, we will firstly focus on information handling including the creation of pictograms, bar charts, and simple Venn and Carroll diagrams. We will progress to naming and describing the features of simple 2D and 3D shapes such as cubes, cuboids, cones, cylinders, spheres, pyramids, pentagons, and hexagons.

Our focus this term is, Health and Wellbeing. Through circle time games and discussions, the stimulus of our lighthouse keeper studies and through learning many Fischy music songs the children will develop knowledge of why it is important and how to:
